The Ogden City Council met in Regular Session on Tuesday, June 8th, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. electronically via conference call at the following phone number: 978-990-5000, access code 413743 and was available to the public to attend in person .

This meeting was conducted electronically due to federal and state government recommendations in response to COVID-19 pandemic conditions, pursuant to Governor Reynolds Proclamation of Disaster Emergency dated March 19, 2020.
