**MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF

CALL TO ORDER
The Ogden Board of Education held a regular board meeting Monday, February 8, 2021 in the Middle and High School Library. Members present included Pete Bergstrom, Leda Burton, Camille Schroeder, and Pete Thomsen. Matt Van Sickle was absent. The meeting was called to order by President Schroeder at 6:43pm, due to technical difficulties. Others present were Superintendent Pam Dodge, Board Secretary Melissa Atwell, and Principal Maury Ruble. Principal Amy Krause and Auditor Nick Stanley of Schnurr & Co joined electronically.

FY2020 Audit Presentation

Nick Stanley of Schnurr & Co reported on the FY20 financial audit. Burton moved to acknowledge receipt of the fiscal year 2020 audit. Thomsen. Motion carried 4-0.

Early Retirement Requests
Bergstrom moved to approve the early retirement applications and resignations from Kathy Ahrens, Susan Casey, Kara Kruse, Holly Thompson, and Normagene Wilson. Burton seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

2021-22 School Calendar
Two drafts of a school calendar and teacher survey data were presented to the board. The proposed calendar will be available on the school website and a public hearing will be held at the March meeting prior to approval.

Construction
Bergstrom moved to approve change order 3 with Badding Construction for \$1216. Thomsen seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Howe Building
The board continued their discussions on the future of Howe. Once the ground has thawed, the site will be surveyed. Dr. Dodge will obtain estimates for asbestos abatement.

Policy Review
The board continued their review of the 200 series. Bergstrom moved for the first and final reading of policies 210.8-212. Thomsen seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

COMMUNICATIONS, DELEGATIONS & PETITIONS
The board calendar was reviewed.

Elementary Principal Report
Amy Krause shared the elementary donated 500 items to the Ogden Food Pantry with a Super Bowl competition food drive. The elementary is currently wrapping up winter screenings, with data indicating significant improvements from fall. The elementary teachers have also taken on new leadership roles in regard to professional development and are really enjoying them. Krause also reported the district reading curriculum is currently under review.

Secondary Principal Report
Maury Ruble stated the secondary is also participating in the reading curriculum review and finishing up their winter assessments. 6-8 grade has shown great improvement from fall to winter and are right on target compared to last year. He also reported attendance is 3.5% higher than last year with high school at over 96% and middle school at over 95%. Ruble also shared an exciting new partnership between the Hospitality, Tourism and Management (HTM) program and Kirkwood. Doralene Abdel-Halim has worked diligently to build this new relationship, and second semester HTM II students will earn 2 college credits through her course and also be eligible to receive special scholarships from Kirkwood.

Superintendent Report
Pam Dodge had two updates for the board. The concrete façade above the high school cafeteria had a weld give way and was in danger of falling through the roof. Our grounds crew was able to create a temporary fix, and engineers are working on drafting a permanent one. The engineer guessed the structural issue was caused by the old swimming pool, and the permanent fix will only need to be for that area and not the entire building. The administrative team has determined district-wide mask policies will remain the same.

ADJOURN
There was no further business to come before the board for consideration. Burton moved to adjourn. Bergstrom seconded. Motion carried 4-0. President Schroeder adjourned the meeting at 8:16pm.
