Bergstrom moved to approve the consent agenda. Burton seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

ACTION ITEMS

Construction

Merle Rambo of Facilities Cost Management Group discussed with the board final punch list items for the activities center construction and the anticipated closeout process and timeline.

Equipment Bids

Bids for activities center equipment were reviewed. Burton moved to approve the weight equipment bid from Push Pedal Pull for \$81,183, scoreboard from Daktronics for \$14,986, and sound system from Forte Studios for \$40,791.59. Van Sickle seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Public Hearing-Real Estate

President Schroeder opened the public hearing on the matter of the proposed conveyance of an interest in real property, with the notice of the proposed action having been published pursuant to the provisions of Section 297.22(1) of the Code of Iowa. No individuals spoke, and the public hearing was closed.

Resolution of a Conveyance of Real Property

Bergstrom moved to approve the resolution for a conveyance of real property and the real estate gift agreement to gift the ballfields on the Howe Property to the City of Ogden. Van Sickle seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

School Business Official Sharing Agreement

Burton moved to approve the School Business Official Sharing Agreement with United Community School. Bergstrom seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Student Fees

Bergstrom moved to approve the 2021-22 student fees. Burton seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Milk and Bread Bids

Burton moved to approve Dean Dairy as milk vendor and Pan-O-Gold as bread vendor for the 2021-22 school year. Van Sickle seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

COMMUNICATIONS, DELEGATIONS & PETITIONS

The board calendar was reviewed.

Howe Site Discussion

Dr. Dodge updated the board on a water main break near Howe that flooded the basement. She is currently working with the insurance company to assess the damage.

Elementary Principal Report

Amy Krause shared the elementary had a great end to the year. Field Day was held at the track for the first time, and students celebrated the last day of school with inflatables and mini golf. After the last student day, staff participated in five days of learning, with everyone leaving rejuvenated for next year. Summer school is off to a great start for 75 elementary students. A new reading curriculum has been purchased for next year, and assessment data showed students ended the year above the AEA and state averages in both reading and math.

Secondary Principal Report

Maury Ruble also reported a great end to the year for middle & high

school students with an 8th grade trip to Adventureland, movies, roller skating, and open campus finals for high schoolers. Summer school is also off to a great start at the secondary with 20 middle school students and 9 high school students participating. He shared information about some exciting new staff additions for the fall, and reported that graduation went very well. The senior trip leaves Saturday, June 19th with 18 students headed west.

Superintendent Report

Dr. Dodge shared the roof replacement cycle will be reviewed and reassessed in July for the upcoming years.

There was no further business to come before the board for consideration. Van Sickle moved to adjourn. Bergstrom seconded. Motion carried 4-0. President Schroeder adjourned the meeting at 7:42pm.
