Dena Sprecher, Karla Kahler, and Linda Trudo all addressed the board with questions, concerns, and comments about the demolition of the building. Lori Anderson shared she was there to listen as a city council member of community thoughts about the land and area. Following comments, Schroeder closed the public hearing and shared a summary of information on the multi-year process to date that brought the board to this decision. Burton then moved to approve the resolution for the demolition of school property. Bergstrom seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

**Construction** 

Thomsen moved to approve the certificates of substantial completion on the activities center project for Badding Construction, Kruck Plumbing, and Jaspering Electric. Van Sickle seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Substitute Pay Rates

Bergstrom moved to approve substitute pay rates for 2021-22 with the only change from the previous year to the substitute nurse rate, matching the substitute teacher rate. Thomsen seconded. Motion carried 5-0
