MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE OGDEN COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT OCTOBER 11, 2021

CALL TO ORDER

The Ogden Board of Education held a regular board meeting Monday, October 11, 2021 in the Middle and High School Library. Members present included Pete Bergstrom, Leda Burton, Camille Schroeder, Pete Thomsen, and Matt Van Sickle. The meeting was called to order by President Schroeder at 6:15pm. Others present were Superintendent Pam Dodge, Board Secretary Melissa Atwell, Principals Amy Krause and Maury Ruble, and 1 guest.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Van Sickle moved to approve the agenda. Bergstrom seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

CLOSED SESSION

Burton moved to enter into closed session pursuant to Iowa Code section 21.5(1)(c) to discuss matters with our legal counsel that are presently in litigation. Van Sickle seconded. Motion carried 5-0. The board entered closed session at 6:16pm. Van Sickle later moved to return to open session. Burton seconded. Motion carried 5-0. The board returned to open session at 6:38pm.

Legal Matters

Burton moved to ratify the settlement our insurance company reached in the pending litigation with Danielle Mooers, and her conservators, in order to resolve all issues in that litigation against the District and any past or present District employee. Thomsen seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Allowable Growth

Bergstrom moved to authorize the district to request \$43,996.03 in allowable growth and supplemental aid for the FY21 special education deficit. Burton seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Policy Review

Burton moved for the first and final reading of policies 300-302.4 and 302.6-303.4, and the first reading of policy 303.5 as part of the board's annual policy review. Van Sickle seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

FY21 Full Financial Report

Melissa Atwell presented to the board the full financial report for FY21.

Elementary Principal Report

Amy Krause shared the elementary staff has focused their attention on purposeful connections and communications with families, including the addition of positive phone calls home. The SIAC committee met last week, where student testing data was shared. Elementary math data is showing improvement, and 85% of students are currently on track to be proficient by the end of the year. One growth opportunity noted for the elementary is building even stronger student-to-student connections.

Secondary Principal Report

Maury Ruble shared the secondary building has been focused on the social/emotional health and well-being of middle school students. Secondary teachers have also begun sharing good news with postcards home to families. He was also excited to report great academic growth seen in the middle school FAST testing, with 21% of 7th graders and 17% of 8th graders testing above last spring's math data.

Superintendent Report

Dr. Dodge shared preliminary enrollment numbers, with the district anticipating to be down less than 5 students this year. She also shared the Howe building demolition documents are being finalized and will be published/sent out to bid in the coming week.

There was no further business to come before the board for consideration. Thomsen moved to adjourn. Burton seconded. Motion carried 5-0. President Schroeder adjourned the meeting at 7:56pm.
